#### **Application requirements:**

- 1.) Fill out an AAARC Scholarship Application by the deadline and mail to: AAARC, P.O. Box 246, Hillsboro, Ohio 45133
- 2.) All Applicants must submit with his or her application, a 300-500 word essay that must include: (Your Bio, Why you choose your field of study, Are you first generation college student, Why do you need the scholarship, How will you use the scholarship money, How will your chosen field help your community and honor your ancestors?)

#### **AAARC Committee Selection Guidelines:**

- 1.) Application and essay must be submitted by the applicant to the committee by December 31, 2020.
- 2.) Committee will meet in January to review applications
  - a. Everyone is eligible to fill out an application for the minority scholarship given by the AAARC who resides in Highland, Clinton, and/or Fayette Counties in Ohio and who is, has, or will be a graduating high school student in 2020 and/or 2021.
  - b. A winner and first runner up will be selected in the event the winner is not able to utilize the scholarship, the first runner up will then receive the funds.
  - c. If selected the applicant agrees to submit any necessary documentation to support the data he or she provided. Likewise, all correspondence and award agreements will be generated from the personal information submitted by the applicant.
