Clinton County Bar Association Scholarship Qualifications and Procedures

Qualifications

- 1. Applicant must be a high school senior who either lives in Clinton County or is attending a high school in Clinton County, graduating in the current school year, who will be attending a college, university, accredited trade or technical school.
- 2. Applicant must be pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's degree or equivalent vocational degree at an accredited trade or technical school.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Eligibility is based on scholastic achievements, extracurricular activities and volunteer activities in the community.
- 5. A \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded and paid to the recipient upon proof that he/she has been accepted by the school of his/her choice and that he/she is attending said school.

Procedures

- 1. Print in ink or type answers on attached SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION. If more space is needed than provided, please attach additional sheets of paper to the application. **DO NOT STAPLE ANY PAGES OF YOUR APPLICATION OR ATTACHMENTS.**
- 2. Provide letters of recommendation from three adults, at least one of whom is your guidance counselor or teacher. These adults may not be related to applicant.
- 3. Send the completed application, a copy of your school transcript and the three letters of recommendation to the Clinton County Bar Association, c/o Clinton County Law Library, 46 S. South Street, Wilmington, Ohio 45177. **DO NOT STAPLE.**
- 4. Complete application, transcript and letters of recommendation must be mailed and postmarked by the second Friday in April of the current year or it will not be accepted.
- 5. The \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded according to the qualifications listed above.
- 6. The selection process shall be handled by the Clinton County Bar Association Scholarship Committee.
- 7. The scholarship recipient will be announced after the first Friday in May of the current school year. The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient does not attend a college, university, trade or technical school within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.
