

CLINTON COUNTY RETIRED TEACHERS SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD CRITERIA

1. The recipient must be in the upper one-third (1/3) of his/her class or have at least a 2.75 GPA.
2. The recipient must be graduating from a high school in Clinton County (Blanchester, Clinton Massie, East Clinton or Wilmington).
3. The recipient must enroll in a college in a program that leads to a teaching certificate.
4. The recipient must exhibit positive characteristics of leadership, service, and character.
5. Financial need may be considered in the selection; however, the award is not made on need alone.
6. Applicants for the scholarship will not be discriminated against because of race, religion, sex, or politics.

PAYMENT

The payment for the scholarship will be made directly to the college of enrollment by the Treasurer of The Clinton County Foundation. (\$750 per semester) – not to exceed \$1,500 for the year. The first payment will be made upon verification of registration and subsequent payment(s) upon presentation of records of “good standing” and continued enrollment. Should the recipient not maintain a record of “good standing” (i.e., he/she is put on academic or disciplinary probation), payment(s) will cease. If the student has good grades and applies on time, he or she may receive another \$500.00 at the time of student teaching.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Scholarship Selection Committee of the Clinton County Chapter of the Ohio Retired Teachers Association may, at its option, interview all applicants submitting applications or select those that it feels are best qualified. Award recipients will be selected from those interviewed.

TIMELINE

1. Applications must be filed with the Clinton County Retired Teachers Scholarship Committee by **Friday, April 2, 2021**. The filing shall be submitted in person or mailed to:
