Robert A. Cunningham Memorial Scholarship

Robert A. Cunningham was a dedicated volunteer at General Electric Credit Union (GECU) for over 30 years. His spirit of volunteerism was seen in his love of youth sports and his commitment to scholastic achievement and college education. This scholarship was created to recognize college-bound high school seniors who embody the spirit of volunteerism like the late Mr. Cunningham.

Five scholarships will be awarded and each scholarship recipient will receive a one-time award of \$2,000.

The applicant must:

- Be a college-bound, graduating high school senior.
- Have a strong academic record with at least a “B” average.
- Be a primary member of GECU; have an account in their name (students may join if they qualify for membership*).
- Have participated in activities demonstrating the spirit of volunteerism.

Applications must also include:

- An essay (see Scholarship Application form for details).
- Two letters of recommendation (one from an organization for which the applicant volunteers).
- An official copy of his or her high school transcript.

**The application and all required documents must be postmarked
or received by 5 pm on Tuesday, January 12, 2021.**

A scholarship committee will review the applications individually and choose several applicants to interview. Interviews will take place in February/March and the committee will then select the recipients. All applicants will be notified of their results by phone and/or mail.

*Students qualify for GECU membership if they: live, work, worship, or attend school in the Ohio counties of: Hamilton, Butler, Warren, Clermont, Montgomery, other Southwest Ohio counties, and in the Kentucky counties of: Boone, Campbell, Grant, Kenton, and Pendleton; and anyone who lives or works in the Indiana counties of: Dearborn, Franklin, Ohio, Switzerland, and Union.
