One (1) \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to a Clinton-Massie senior.

Requirements:

- ❖ You must have financial need or another circumstance that creates a financial challenge for you to attend college.
- ❖ The recipient must attend either a two-year or a four-year college or university.
- ❖ You must have at least a 3.0 GPA (unweighted) to apply.
- ❖ If you are selected as the winner, you **must** write a thank you note to the donors, Dorothy and Bruce Henry.

Selection Process:

Each complete application consists of multiple parts:

- a. Application page
- b. Typed list of activities/awards
- c. Official (signed) transcript
- d. Two recommendation letters
- e. Typed personal statement that demonstrates your financial need (500 words max)

This application is due in the School Counseling office by 2:30 on March 5, 2021.

Any applications that are incomplete or untrue will not be considered for the award. Winners will be notified at the Seniors Awards Night on May 26, 2021.
